

Education Courses You Probably Didn't Care For

EDU 2010 A Survey of Obsolete Educational Technologies 5 Credits

Students will become familiar with mimeograph machines, cassette players, film strip and 16 mm projectors, overhead machines, typewriters and chalk. Hands-on experience.

EDU 2020 A Line by Line Analysis of the Education Act 1 Credit

Students will become familiar with the Alberta Education Act, and will be required to remember all 375 subsections and 37 amendments. Two hour class beginning at 8 am every morning. The final examination in this course is worth 80% of the students' mark.

EDU 2030 Dealing with Accidents 5 Credits

How to cope with puddles under a desk and strange smells coming from that little boy in the back row. Hands-on experience.

EDU 2040 Secrets of Successful First-Year Teachers 5 Credits

Students will learn how to cope with the stresses of the first year of teaching, by examining such strategies as 'Getting to Know Your Office Manager', 'Using Your Sick Day Allowance Effectively', and 'Hiding Out in the Washroom: An Overview'.

EDU 3100 What You Don't Want to Know About Teaching 5 Credits

A detailed look at the little known and often overlooked down side of being a Primary teacher. Topics to be discussed include 'Playground Supervision at 20 Below', 'Filling Out Field Trip Forms', 'Christmas Concert Rehearsals', and 'Scheduling Bathroom Breaks'.

EDU 4400 Managing Your Glue Sticks 5 Credits

How to store and distribute glue sticks, with an emphasis on what to do when students eat them.

EDU 4450 Prohibited Elementary PhysEd Games 1 Credit

Students will gain experience in recognizing PhysEd games which have been prohibited at the Elementary level. Examples include 'Medicine Ball Dodgeball', 'Red Rover Red Rover Send That Really Big Kid Over', 'Pin the Tail on the Teacher', and 'Indoor Lawn Darts'.

EDU 4770 Managing and Cataloguing Your Coloured Pencils 1 Credit

While it is true that Elementary teachers must provide supplies such as coloured pencils for classroom use, often overlooked is the necessity to properly manage these resources. Topics covered will include cataloguing by colour using Excel spreadsheets, labelling, and removing teeth marks.

EDU 3150 The Well Dressed Teacher 1 Credit

An in-depth look at the proper wardrobe necessary for first year teachers, with an emphasis on style and the latest fashions. Students will be expected to purchase and model their own clothing selections for the class.

EDU 3180 Operating and Maintaining the School Photocopier 1 Credit

EDU 4200 Multiple Choice Final Exams in Grade 1 5 Credits

Students will construct and analyze multiple choice final examinations in Math, Writing, Science and Drawing with Crayons. Students will be expected to write and pass the exams they have created.

EDU 4250 Dealing With Irrational Assistant Principals 5 Credits

This compulsory course will examine strategies for dealing with Assistant Principals who fly off the handle, behave irrationally, weep uncontrollably, and eat other teachers' lunches.
