Photography Information

Sign out a camera from the teacher.

- 1. Shoot all your pictures in black and white.
- 2. In most cases your photos will not be printed when you hand them in. If you want to make prints of your work, consider buying an inexpensive half-size photo album to use as a portfolio. You may print your photos in the classroom if you pay for ink and paper: \$1.00 per full page.
- 3. If you have your own digital camera, consider taking some photos (for any assignment you may be working on) at home, possibly on weekends. You will have a wider range of lighting (early morning, dusk, noon, etc) and a wider range of subject material and interesting locations.
- 4. Try to shoot all your pictures using natural light (no flash). If you do all your picture taking at school, this will mean standing near a doorway or window, or moving outside.
- 5. If you change any setting on the camera, make sure they're changed back before you return the camera.
